


It is to submit that, the Pedda Cheruvu, Nacharam is situated in Nacharam (V), Uppal (V), Medchal-Malkajgiri District. The FTL area of this tank is 108.3 Acres with catchment area of 35.40 Sq.km, water spread area of 81.710 Acres and capacity of 54.91 Mcft. This tank was used to serve an Ayacut of 302.37 Acres. The upper sources of this tank are 1) Mukkidi Cheruvu, R.K.Puram, 2) Nadimi Cheruvu, Safilguda, 3) Banda Cheruvu, Malkajgiri & 4) Patel Cheruvu, Nacharam and lower source is Nalla Cheruvu, Uppal and then the stream merges into River Musi.

There is no separate drainage network for storm water and sewer water in the catchment of this tank. The sewer drains laid in the catchment for carrying the house hold and commercial sewer are merged long back into natural streams (Presently Nalas). These Nalas which are connected from tank to tank are carrying the untreated sewer into the lakes and thus polluting the lake waters. The foam formation is due to gushing out of polluted lake water at the outlet location during surplus.

In the periphery of Pedda Cheruvu, Nacharam there is an existing Sewerage Treatment Plant of 10 MLD, whereas the sewer inflows are around 50 to 60 MLD i.e. more than 5 to 6 times of the treating capacity. There are peripheral sewer drains laid earlier along the periphery to prevent entry into lake,

these lines are directed to downstream sewer network drains. There is a 30 MLD STP established by HMWS&SB at downstream of Nalla Cheruvu, Uppal which is treating sewer from Nacharam lake as well as sewer generated in the catchment and joining the nala enroute.

The GHMC has taken up certain lake development work with a tune of Rs.3.14 Crores of Pedda Cheruvu, Nacharam like removal of Garbage and other deleterious material lying along lake boundary, formation of peripheral walking track, fencing to prevent unauthorized entry as well as to curb debris dumping and providing access control gate for entry and exit. In addition to the above work the maintenance work for removal of water hyacinth at regular intervals is also in progress.

It is to state that, the Hyderabad Metro Water Supply & Sewerage Board Department has planned a comprehensive sewerage network treatment plan by establishing STP's at appropriate locations within GHMC area and in arresting the entry of un-treated sewer into lakes.
